PLEASE SHARE WITH YOUR TEAM AND THEIR PARENTS!

- NH-DI is a volunteer organization, so please be sure to say THANK YOU to ALL the volunteers helping you here today.
- Also please say **THANK YOU** to the administration, staff and custodial crew of Souhegan High School for graciously hosting this event!
- PROPS!!! Please bring in your props about an hour before your performance, but no earlier than that if possible. Space is at a premium, so keep props in your vehicle(s) until you need them. After your presentation, promptly remove your props from the building, so all teams can share the limited space.
- Our expectations are that everyone will exhibit good sportsmanship, respect for each other, have a positive attitude and will face all obstacles as CHALLENGES to be solved creatively.
- PLEASE! Remind all participants and parents NOT to enter or exit a room while a presentation is taking place! This is to insure optimal performance conditions for all teams. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
- Engineering Challenge Teams: Plan to arrive at Roller Coaster Check-In 40 minutes before the time of your Team Challenge presentation. The first three teams of the day should arrive 90 minutes before their presentation, so we can start the check-in process early enough for them to be able to leave for the Banner Parade.
- Teams should report to Instant Challenge 20 minutes before your scheduled IC time. To reduce congestion at check in, leave all bags, electronics, and timekeeping devices with someone else before you bring your team to IC. Team managers with more than one team may only enter IC with the team that has their IC last.
- Please do not use glue, paint, or anything that might damage the floors, and take care when moving scenery and props into and out of the building. We want to be respectful guests!
- Please do not go into areas that have been taped off or posted as "NO ADMITTANCE."
- Please <u>do not</u> use the school's water and snack machines. Consider them OFF LIMITS! Please support the local programs selling food and beverages at this meet.
- Keep the cafeterias clear of personal items and toss out that trash! Space is limited, and everyone needs table space to eat! Please do not take food and drink (other than water) into other areas of the school!
- Remember to take some **team photos** in our photo booth area during your free time.
- Be sure to check out the Gnome Zone! Visit the activity rooms, take a silly team photo, be prepared to dance at the Bakery Boogie, and take a chance at the wonderful prizes offered in the Raffle Showcase.
- **TEAM MANAGERS:** Stop by the Information Center after 1:00 PM for a break from the day. Come and enjoy a snack break with fellow Team Managers!
- Team Managers should review **raw scores** approximately 30 minutes after your team's performance. Head Appraisers will usually post a list of the teams that have scores ready to

review. If your team has a late afternoon presentation, look for your Head Appraiser in the Appraiser Room at the end of the day.

- We have a small First Aid kit available at the Information Table; however, no medications are available.
- Lost & Found items should be taken to the Information Table.
- IMPORTANT: Before heading to the Closing Celebration in the Main Gym, please, please, PLEASE empty the cafeteria, halls, stairwells, etc. of all kids, personal items, and trash. The Awards Ceremony will NOT begin until the cafeteria and other areas are clean!
- FYI -- The tournament will end when our Score Room officials and the tournament directors are satisfied that all scores are in and have been accurately tabulated. Therefore, the time of the Award Ceremony is approximate, but it should begin sometime around 5:00 PM.
- Advancement to the State Tournament is based on the number of teams **COMPETING.** Some might be non-competitive teams that are only presenting their solution.
